Thank you for your interest in Aim High School for your incoming 6th-12th grader. New applicants are interviewed throughout the year and accepted on a rolling basis. Enclosed you will find the necessary application forms and materials to apply for admission for your son or daughter.

At Aim High School, we are dedicated to providing 6th-12th grade students with an excellent education that encourages both academic and social success. The first step in the admissions process is to arrange a visit to the campus – which you may have already completed if you are receiving this packet. The next step is to schedule a two-hour class visit for your student and complete the application materials. We have included an admissions checklist and the appropriate forms to guide you through the entire process.

In order to determine if your student could benefit from our program, we also ask you to provide documentation relevant to your son or daughter – copies of IEP, 504 plan, psychological evaluation, transcripts/grades, current courses, and any additional information you feel would be helpful in the decision making process. We request that you provide this information prior to or at the time of the two-hour class visit.

We invite all parents to apply for financial aid. The school currently partners with Financial Aid for School Tuition (FAST). You can begin the tuition assistance application process on our website. All information from FAST remains confidential and is reviewed by the school's Financial Aid Committee.

Please refer to the items below to guide you through the admission process:

- Contact the school to schedule a campus visit and tour
- Schedule two-hour student class visit and complete Application for Admission packet
- Prior to the class visit, provide copies of transcripts/grade reports, Psychological Evaluation, IEP or 504 Plan, current class schedule, and additional documents that will aid in admissions decision
- Schedule all day student class visit (additional class visits are required on an individual basis)
- After visits, Admissions Office sends admissions decision via email or mail
- If acceptance offered and agreeable, schedule pre-enrollment meeting with Head of School, sign contract, & pay deposit
- Complete enrollment documents
